Filmmakers and actors will join us at the festival to present their work and bring some extra background and insight to our screenings. The filmmakers will also be coming to Amsterdam to present their films and chat about them with you after the screenings.

True to tradition, ASFF opens with the powerful film ***Escobar/ Loving Pablo***, directed by the internationally acclaimed Spanish director Fernando León de Aranoa and the great **Javier Bardem** and the sensational **Penélope Cruz** in the leading roles. The director will attend the opening night to introduce his latest film at Pathé Tuschinski.

The Festival is delighted to welcome filmmaker **Ramón Salazar** to this year's edition, presenting his new extraordinary film ***La enfermedad del domingo***, coming straight from Berlinale this year 2018.

Our new section ***Spain Laughs*** will host actors **Paco León**, **Carmen Machi** and the greatest **Julita Salmerón** who will be attending to present their work in the films ***La Tribu***, ***Thi Mai*** and ***Muchos hijos, un mono y un castillo***. We promise that you will not regret meeting them.

Similar to our previous edition, we will also offer a ***Focus Latino*** this year; a showcase dedicated in this edition to discovering and celebrating Argentinian Cinema by introducing an interesting variety of films.

Following on from last year's music-documentary connection, this edition we bring two revelatory documentaries about the fantastic journey through the successful musical careers of **Alejandro Sanz** and **Diego "El Cigala"**. The live performance will be offered this year after the documentary part of the core program ***Luna grande, un tango por García Lorca***. **Almudena Rubio** will be performing some of the Lorca's poems and bring you a bit closer to the great Andalusian poet.

We are also very proud to include ***Spanish Cinema Without Fear*** once again in our program, a special film section with a variety of Spanish works that have the courage to experiment with something beyond and on the periphery of the Spanish cinematographic industry. Some of the filmmakers will also join us to talk about their creative work. **Elena Martín** will be present to talk about her fantastic debut film ***Julia Ist.***

A classic in our festival is the section ***Treasure from the Past***, an unmissable opportunity to re-discover some of the forgotten gems of Spanish cinematography. This year ***Amantes***, a film based on a real crime that took place in the 1940s, full of intrigue, passions and strong erotic content will be screened at EYE.

Furthermore, in this fourth edition ASFF is happy to introduce another new section: ***Spain Meets***, where Spain meets Japan in an exceptional culinary experience.

And last but not least, we must not forget our now incredibly popular Spanish party at Ketelhuis, where we invite you all onto the dance floor on Saturday night. Our tropical Spanish DJ will make it impossible for you not to shake those hips and move your feet. The party gets on its way right after the première of ***Thi Mai*** and will have you dancing until 3am. The first drink is on us because we can't wait to see you get down on the dance floor!
